Name of Scholarship

United Women in Faith Scholarship

Purpose

The Scholarship Committee of the Gethsemane UWFaith will present a monetary award to a young woman of Christian faith, who is a member of Gethsemane United Methodist Church and is pursuing a degree from an accredited institution of higher learning.

Eligibility

1. Graduating high school senior.
2. A continuing college or university student.
3. Successful completion of all high school/college requirements with a minimum grade point average of 2.00.
4. Acceptance for admission or continued enrollment in college/university.
5. Member of Gethsemane United Methodist Church.

Amount of Award

The scholarship award shall range from \$100 - \$500 as determined by the Committee.

Application Process

1. Each applicant (including continuing students) must submit the following information:
 - a. Fully completed official application form.
 - b. Copy of the official high school report card/transcript or college grade sheet/transcript.
 - c. College/University Acceptance Letter (for high school graduates)
 - d. Two letters of reference from adults (persons not related to you)
 - e. A one-page essay telling the committee about yourself, the reason(s) for applying for this scholarship, and the anticipated use of the funds.

Criteria for Selection of Recipient

1. The committee will select the recipient based on scholastic ability and school, community, and church involvement. Personal traits such as motivation, honesty, responsibility, and concern for others will also play an important part in the selection process.
2. Awards will not be granted to an individual in successive years. No more than two awards will be given to the same person within a four-year period; moreover, evidence of continued academic progress must be demonstrated.
3. Incomplete applications will not be considered. No Exceptions.

Important Dates

1. Final date for the submission of completed application – Sunday, June 9, 2024 (12 midnight).
2. Award notification will be Sunday, June 23, 2024.
